

Lansdale Catholic High School Middle States Objectives

Student Performance Objective #1 – Community Service

By 2023, Lansdale Catholic High School will provide opportunities outside the classroom for student faith formation, participation in liturgical and communal prayer, and action in service of social justice as measured by the following:

1. Seniors involved in Kairos Retreat will increase by 15 each year until all seniors take part in the retreat.
2. Increase, by 100 %, the number of Community Service Corps (CSC) members, meaning the student must have attended at least 4 CSC sponsored events.
3. Increase, by 20% each year, the number of students who complete more than 30 service hours.

Student Performance Objective #2 - College Readiness:

By 2023, Lansdale Catholic High School students will improve their academic skills allowing them to successfully pursue college entrances and completion by the following:

1. A 2 % increase in PSAT test scores each year from ninth to eleventh grades.
(Baseline to be established in the 2015-2016 school year due to new PSAT format.)
2. Increase the number of students who score 3 or above on Advanced Placement (AP) tests.
3. Increase the number of student opportunities to complete at least one additional course not offered at the school (On-line, Diocesan Scholar, Dual-Credit, etc.)
4. Increase, by 10%, the number of students in grades 9, 10, 11 and 12 who attain first and second honors in the final grade.

Student Performance Objective #3 - Career Awareness:

By 2023, Lansdale Catholic High School will improve students' lifelong learning skills, allowing them to investigate and successfully pursue post-secondary career options as measured by the following:

1. Increase, by 10%, student involvement in career awareness by attendance at programs to help students develop a personal action plan and goal for future career choices.
2. Increase, by 10%, the number of students taking leadership roles in the school community.

Organizational Objective #1 - Technology

By 2023, Lansdale Catholic High School will upgrade and facilitate the utilization of technology in the classroom as measured by:

1. Attaining a Student to personal technology ratio of 1:1 using BYOD (Bring Your Own Device).
(Baseline to be established in the 2015-2016 school year due to staff retirements, new hires and the upgraded system work begun in the Summer, 2015.)
2. By 2023, all students will use technology for academic purposes for 25% of the school day.
