INTERNATIONAL SENIORS:

Many of you need to transfer your I-20 to a U.S. university. Please see Ms. Ardoff and bring any paperwork from your university that you need to transfer the I-20. If you are returning to your home country for college, you do not need to transfer the I-20 but you need to let Ms. Ardoff know.

INTERNATIONAL FRESHMAN, SOPHOMORES AND JUNIORS:

In order for you to return to the U.S. in September, you need to have the signature on the third page of your I-20 updated. Please bring your original I-20 to Ms. Ardoff so she can send it to the Archdiocese for signature. This applies whether you are leaving the U.S. to go home or simply leaving the country to go on vacation (e.g. to Canada or another country). This applies to ALL international freshmen, sophomores and juniors unless you hold an American passport.
